Business Manager's Notes

- I encourage everyone to get vaccinated. The more people that get vaccinated the quicker we return to normal.
- 401k merger completed- be sure to register beneficiaries and your account online. If you aren't currently participating, now would be a great time to get started. Contact the office to get more information.
- Effective June 1, 2021 \$.60 non-credited will begin to be credited eliminating all non credited contributions. This money will be at the multiplier of 1.
- There will not be an increase in H&W. The Alt Plan now has disability like the Full Base Plan.
- We are in negotiations with Bodine Motor Shop.
- Inside wage allocation to take place at the May union meeting. We will be deciding where to allocate \$1.60.
- The EIU arbitration was a success for requiring extra pay for "mask-time".
- Hazardous Material Workforce Bill (HB 3437) has passed the IL House of Representatives. Representative Sue
 Scherer was the only local representative supporting our bill. This bill requires certain hazardous location facilities to
 employ workers in registered apprenticeship programs and pay the IL prevailing wage. There is also an incentive for
 contractors to employ minorities and penalties for companies that violate the training or prevailing wage provisions.
- Energy Legislation is still pending as well as a Federal Infrastructure Bill that would create thousands of electrical infrastructure jobs across Illinois.
- Congratulations to the new journeymen that just completed their apprenticeship.
- Work outlook is good for the foreseeable future. If you are out of work please monitor the job hotline. We have had several calls and many are getting into Book 2.
