David "Kent" Spesard, 69, of Peoria, Arizona, passed away on February 10, 2025. He was born on June 19, 1955, in Shelbyville, Illinois. He graduated from Shelbyville High School and Lake Land College. He worked for Burdick Electronics before beginning his IBEW electrical apprenticeship.
